**NOTICE OF OBJECTION TO EXECUTIVE SESSION**

COMES NOW, M. Sue Sheridan Jarrett as a person with party status in the above referenced rulemaking proceeding files this Notice of Objections to the Executive Session found on the website for a September 4<sup>th</sup> executive session meeting.

This information was not sent to the parties to the rule making proceeding by the commission or the staff to the commission. Furthermore, it does not give a location for the meeting for interested parties to attend. I placed a call to Jan Missey on Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2008, and she did not give me any information and stated I needed to talk to the hearing staff and forwarded my call to Rob Willis. I left a voice message and as of 9 am this morning of September 4<sup>th</sup> I have still not received answers to my question on location and service to parties of the rule making proceedings. I live over three hours driving time from Denver and was not given proper notice to attend any meeting.

Furthermore, I join in the **NOTICE OF OBJECTION TO THE SCHEDULED SEPTEMBER 4TH EXECUTIVESESSION MEETING OF THE COLORADO OIL AND GAS CONSERVATIONCOMMISSION AND MOTION TO PRESERVE MINUTES OF PRIOR EXECUTIVE SESSION PROCEEDINGS PENDING FINAL AGENCY ACTION** as filed by CPA and COGA as if set forth in full herein. I concur that the notice once again fails to meet the requirements of the "Sunshine Law" regarding open meetings and allowances for executive sessions. Not all attorney/client conversations are privileged under the "Sunshine Law" for executive sessions and the burden of proof has not been met.

Once again I state, the commission is out of time for proceeding with this rule making as the HB 08-1379 only gave them until July 16, 2008 for action on the rules. Again I state that certain members of this commission, staff members, and other parties are attorneys and are sworn to uphold the law and cannot take it upon themselves to violate the law. They must honor their own statements on record and the laws as passed and made statutory law and the administrative proceeds that govern this commission.

Furthermore, I fully incorporate all previous objections and motions filed to these rule making proceedings as if set forth in full herein and state that the commission has again

fail to respond to my motions in a timely fashion as I objected to further proceedings and put forth a motion to stay. And once again I make a record that I believe that my due process as a party status individual has been violated
