COLORADO SUPPLEMENTAL PROPOSAL ON HEARING TIME ALLOCATIONS

COMES NOW, the Board of County Commissioners of Garfield County, State of Colorado ("BOCC"), by and through their attorney, Don K. DeFord, Garfield County Attorney, and herein submits a Supplemental Proposal on the Conduct of Hearing and Time Allocations.

1. Throughout this proceeding, Garfield County has participated as a party and has attempted to participate as part of the sub-group denominated "governmental entities".

2. On the 27th of May, 2008, Garfield County received and reviewed a draft proposal of the lead government for the sub-group. After review of that proposal, Garfield County agreed that it conformed to the agreement of the entities and the representation to the Oil and Gas Commission concerning desired participation of the government entities, specifically of Garfield County. Confirmation of the Garfield County concurrence was sent by email on that date.

3. On the 28th of May, 2008, through review of the COGCC website, Garfield County determined that a formal proposal of "government entities" had been submitted to the Director of the Oil and Gas Commission. While Garfield County agrees with the substance of that submittal, Garfield County was omitted as a participating governmental entity.

4. In spite of the foregoing omission, Garfield County still wishes to participate as part of the government entity group, utilizing approximately fifteen (15) minutes in order to formally submit its written testimony and brief supplemental testimony of an official Garfield County representative.


5. Garfield County does not foresee the need to participate in any individual rulemaking.

6. Garfield County, if omitted from the government entity group, may need to participate for the entire course of the hearing, a level of participation that is time consuming, expensive and unnecessary if a Garfield County representative is allowed to participate as part of the government entity group.

Therefore, Garfield County supports the request of the government entities if Garfield County is allowed to participate as part of their one-day, five-hour presentation. If not allowed to participate in that manner, Garfield County objects to the entry of the alternate proposal of the government entities.
